

C. Fees:

ARTICLE IX PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern the proceedings of the Ladies Aid/LWML of Wykoff in all cases in which they are applicable, and are not inconsistent with these bylaws of Christian charity.

ARTICLE IX—AMENDMENTS

These bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote with previous notice and after being reviewed by the district Bylaws Committee.

2. Sewing Committee, with duties performed by the Naomi - Dorcas Circles.

Prepares items for quilts and oversees tying of quilts, sends Goodie Boxes to military members; oversees church and school cleaning. Serves as Hostess at Ladies Aid/LWML meetings as assigned.

3. Christian Care Committee, with duties performed by Rebecca Circle.

Serves at funerals, helps with emergencies that arise in the congregation, sends cards to the sick and shut-ins, prepares and delivers goodie plates to shut-ins. Serves as Hostess at Ladies Aid/LWML meetings as assigned.

ARTICLE VIII—FINANCES

A. FUNDS with which the society is to operate shall be provided by dues from each member as designated by the society at the annual meeting in November.

- Contact the alternate delegate if they cannot attend the Zone Delegate board meeting or District LWML Convention.

ARTICLE VII STANDING COMMITTEES

Serving at dinners, auction sales, anniversaries and weddings of congregation members (anniversaries and weddings at church only). Serves as Hostess at Ladies Aid/ LWML meetings as assigned.

- Altar Committee, with duties performed by the Anna Circle.
- Food Committee, with duties performed by the Martha Circle.

D. Vacancies

 In the event of a vacancy, the Executive Board shall appoint someone to fill the vacancy until the next election, except in the vacancy of the president, when the vice president will assume the position.

ARTICLE V—MEETINGS

Ladies Aid/LWML meetings will be held (6) times per year, beginning in January, March, May, July, September and November. Circles will meet the (6) six alternating months of February, April, June, August, October and December.

• Each meeting will consist of a Bible study and the business that needs to be brought forth.

ARTICLE VI—LWML DELEGATES

The LWML Delegates are determined as follows:

The <u>immediate past president serves as the head</u> <u>delegate</u>; the <u>president</u> is the <u>second delegate</u>; and the <u>vice president</u> is the <u>alternate delegate</u>.

DESCRIPTION OF MEMBERSHIP

ACTIVE MEMBER

An *active* member will attend as many meetings as possible of the Circle she is in; including the Ladies Aid and other LWML functions such as: rallies, retreats, workshops, and conventions. She should participate in the duties and projects assigned her Circle. She will contribute dues and be asked for donations (including time). She will receive a program, a Quarterly, and a Mite Box.

INACTIVE MEMBER

A member of the Ladies Aid who wants to be an inactive member, should make a written request to the board. She will still contribute dues and be asked for donations as needed. She will receive a program, a Quarterly, and a Mite Box; but is not active in attending meetings.

HONORARY MEMBER

Any Ladies Aid member who, because of age or for health reasons, is prevented from being as active as she would like, may ask to be an Honorary Member. She may be as active as she wishes. She will receive a program, a Quarterly, and a Mite Box.

C. Nominations and Elections

- 1. The Nominating Committee is comprised of the Vice President, Recording Secretary, Treasurer, and Christian Life Chairman. They shall strive to submit a ballot of two (2) names per office to be filled.
- 2. Election of officers is held at the annual meeting in November. Election shall be by ballot if determined necessary. Elections may be taken by voice vote if there is only one nominee per position.
- 3. Term of office of the President and Vice President shall be for one year; Secretary, Treasurer and Christian Life Chairman shall be for two years beginning with the January meeting, or until a successor is elected.
- 4. Officers are elected as follows: a Vice President shall be elected each year; assuming the presidency her second year. A Vice President, Treasurer, and Christian Life Chairman are elected in the odd numbered years, and a Vice President and Recording Secretary are elected in the even numbered years.

4. The TREASURER shall:

- ⇒ collect dues and receive moneys for the society
- ⇒ disburse funds according to the direction of the society
- ⇒ keep an accurate record and account of all receipts and disbursements
- ⇒ give a financial report at each meeting of the society
- ⇒ be a member of the Scholarship Fund Committee
- ⇒ prepare financial records for review at the conclusion of her term

5. The CHRISTIAN LIFE Chairman shall:

- ⇒ encourage Bible study and prayer.
- ⇒ provide each member with an LWML Quarterly and Mite Box, and promote their use
- ⇒ forward a copy of original material developed within the society to the District Christian Life Chairman, along with a copy of the society yearly program.
