Pandemic Guidelines
2020-2021**

The following guidelines have been put in place for the health and safety of all individuals involved (players, coaches, officials, spectators, facility staff, etc). Each participating school in the conference has agreed to abide by these guidelines as we look to proceed with athletics for 2020-2021.

Masks / Face Coverings - All spectators, bench personnel (coaches and players), game assistants, and other individuals within the school building will wear a mask. Players will also wear a mask during competition. Per MSHSL rules a player may obtain a medical exemption from their doctor. This exemption must be in written form and on file with the school.

Spectator / Capacity - Minnesota State High School League guidelines call for the spectator limit to be at no more than 25% of the facility's capacity.

- Two passes per family will be issued for game attendance.
 - A physical pass must be presented at the door for admittance to the game.
- Anyone one year of age or older must have a pass.
- Spectators are encouraged to only watch the game in which their child is playing in.
- Players are not included in this count.

Seating / Social Distancing -

- All spectators are expected to sit with household members.
- Spectators are expected to social distance in the stands.
- Spectators should remain seated while games are being played.
- Spectators may not stand in the entrances to gyms.
- Players must sit with parents if not in the game being played.

Streaming - If / when streaming is available the live stream information should be made available to both the home and visiting schools to share with families.

Other

- If a school or classroom goes into a distance learning model then basketball competition for that school or the students in that classroom will be suspended for that particular school until the quarantine period is over.
- No concessions will be offered.
- No locker rooms will be available.

Games Played at Alternate Sites

- "Home" teams will pay for officials
- "Home" team will also provide 1 individual for game management (scoreboard) and 2 line judges for each game. It will be up to the "home" team to decide whether or not to compensate these individuals.
- "Home" team will work with Host Site for any other necessary game details, cleaning, or rental agreements.
